### Question and Answer Sheet

#### Q. Where is the temporary library?

- A. The library has moved to 812 Main Street Osterville. We are located the right hand side as you face the Osterville Baptist Church. We are located on the lower floor.

#### Q. Where do I park and how do I enter?

- A. There is parking in the rear of the building or in the community parking lot at the back of the Osterville Baptist Church. You may enter from the rear parking lot. The library is on the lower floor. You may also enter from Main Street toward the right side of the building where there is ramp access.

#### Q. Who are you using for construction management services?

- A. Carr Enterprises has extensive experience in construction throughout Cape Cod. Among other projects, Carr Enterprises built the Science Center at Cape Cod Academy and have recently completed the new *Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church* in Wellfleet.

#### Q. Who are the architects?

- A. The New Osterville Village Library was designed in part by Ted Bellingrath and then after Ted's passing, by classmate and friend, Jerry Ford III.

#### Q. When will the new library be completed?

- A. If all goes as planned, the new Library will be open within 13 to 15 months. We hope to be open sometime during the winter of 2011/2012.

#### Q. What programs will you have?

- A. The temporary library will hold as many of our others programs as we have available space. Children's Story time programs will continue as usual according to our regular schedule. We will hold as many meetings as we can accommodate and will host author visits and other programs in local venues such as the Osterville Baptist Church, Library Green, St. Peter's Church and others.

#### Q. Will you still have children's programs?

- A. Yes, we will continue the children's story time hours on Tuesday from 3:30-4:15 pm and Wednesday from 10:00 – 10:45. Other programs will be listed on our website in the Calendar page and Children's pages. [www.ostervillevillagelibrary.org](http://www.ostervillevillagelibrary.org)

#### Q. Will there be meeting space available?

- A. Yes, we will still be able to host small groups from time to time and can help find other spaces for your groups to meet. Our book clubs are still meeting at the library and some have been set up for other venues. The best thing to do is to call the library and ask for the Assistant Director.

#### Q. Regarding the new building, how can I help?

- A. There are many opportunities to help both financially, or by purchasing tiles, mural and donor wall entries, and certificates.
